



How to become a Healthy Cities Tutor?

Step 1: You decide that you want to volunteer.



Step 2: Fill out the volunteer application by going to healthycitiestutoring.org and clicking on the blue button that says "Volunteer." Complete all fields and be as specific as possible so that we can make a good match for you. Alternatively you can fill out a hard copy of the volunteer application



Step 3: All applicants are asked to review and acknowledge the child safety policies. If you are 18 years or older, you will need to be fingerprinted and possibly provide proof of a negative TB test. (You will receive information about this once you submit your application.)



Step 4: You will be contacted by a Healthy Cities Site Coordinator who will work with teachers at your preferred school(s) to match you with a student, based on your availability and preferences.



Step 5: Once matched with a student, you will receive a placement email with instructions for your first day of tutoring. Please keep in contact throughout the year with the student's teacher (and possibly the student's parents) to ensure everybody is on the same page.
