Consider making an appointment with your student's teacher. A 10-minute face-to-face meeting is helpful for tutors to know where to focus time with their student. Email teacher(s) with this request, offer a variety of times to meet, and be specific: *"I can meet you on Tuesday or Thursday before school at 7:45 or after school."*

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
