



Board games, cards, catch, draw, color, playdough, dolls, etc.





Build relationships


The time and effort of connecting put into the beginning of the relationship will payoff time and time again

Create a schedule together

It's okay to schedule breaks, play time, snack time, etc. Use your judgment and ask your student how they feel about the schedule. It's okay to change the schedule as needed.


